# **Sue's Swim School – Code of Conduct (For Parents and Swimmers)**

Effective from: September 2025

Applies to: All swimmers, Parents, Guardians and Carers

## 1. Purpose

This Code of Conduct sets out the standards of behaviour we expect from all swimmers, parents, and guardians to ensure a safe, respectful, and enjoyable swimming environment for everyone. By attending lessons, you agree to follow these guidelines.

#### 2. For Swimmers

To keep yourself and others safe and to make the most of your lessons, we ask all swimmers to:

- Listen carefully to instructors and follow their instructions at all times.
- Treat other swimmers and staff with respect no physical contact in an aggressive or unsafe manner.
- Follow pool safety rules:
  - No running on poolside
  - No pushing or dunking
  - Go to the toilet before your lesson starts
  - o Arrive on time for your class
- When you arrive, go to your allotted waiting area on the poolside. If you are unsure where to go, a member of staff will help you.
- Wait until your teacher or assistant calls you before entering the water.

## 3. For Parents & Guardians

We welcome parents and guardians to spectate, but to ensure a safe and focused learning environment, please:

- Allow teachers to teach minimise (and preferably avoid) contact with your child during their lesson.
- No electronics (phones, tablets, games consoles, cameras) on poolside or in the changing rooms for anyone, including siblings.
  - This rule is in place to protect the privacy and safety of all children.
  - If you see someone using a phone or other device, please let a staff member know and we will deal with it.
- Respect that the entire school site is a no smoking and no vaping area.
- No outdoor shoes on the poolside this helps keep the area clean and safe from hazards such as glass or dirt.

### 4. Breaches of the Code

- Ask parents or guardians to leave the pool area
- In serious or repeated cases, review continued participation in our lessons
