A Proven Approach to School Swimming

Designed by teachers, focused on KS2 outcomes

Sue's Swim School's school swimming provision is led by Andy, a former primary school teacher with 11 years' experience in education, including 10 years as a PE Coordinator, alongside qualification as a swimming teacher since 1998.

During his time in schools, Andy consistently saw swimming provision fail to deliver meaningful outcomes for pupils. In response, lesson delivery and assessment were restructured to focus on confidence, skill development and measurable progress rather than attendance alone.

The impact was clear. Where previously around 20% of pupils met the national swimming requirements, structured delivery saw this rise to over 90% at KS2 in recent academic years.

Schools are also provided with clear supporting evidence and reporting, enabling them to demonstrate provision, progress and outcomes for end-of-year PE reporting and OFSTED inspection.
